

ENHANCING YOUR TEACHING WITH THE LCD PROJECTOR

Connected To A Computer

Some things you can do:

- ✓ Demonstrate how to do something in a software program.
- ✓ Show a power point presentation for a lesson.
- ✓ Use the internet in a whole group activity.
- ✓ Use as a calculator viewscreen.
- ✓ Display a graph while doing real-time data collection.

Technical Tips:

- Connect the monitor cable to the computer first, then the end you don't use will fit into just one port in the projector.
- Turn on the projector before you turn on the computer.
- You may need to change the resolution on your computer to a lower number, depending on what the projector can take.
- If you don't see the display on both the computer and the screen, keep pressing Fn + F3 (LCD/CRT) until you do.
- On some laptops you may have to reduce the size of the display (probably F4) until the projector picks up the signal, then you may change it back.

Connected To A VCR

- ✓ Use the LCD projector as a large TV screen.

Technical Tips:

- Make sure the cords that come with the LCD projector are connected to both the VCR and the projector:
 - Grey cord: Video out on the VCR to Video In on the projector.
 - Black cord with red and white jacks: Left and right Video Out on the VCR to left and right Video In on the projector (matching colors of jacks).
- Nothing will show until you press PLAY on the VCR.

Connected To A Digital Camera

- ✓ You can show pictures from a digital camera on a screen.

Technical Tips:

- Make sure you don't have the computer monitor plug connected to the projector.
- Plug camera into the projector's audio (white) and video (yellow) input jacks.
- Set up camera for external viewing.
